- 1. It was agreed at the meeting of this group in April 2012 that the success of the Unit Reduction Pledge would be assessed on three levels:
 - i) Individual company level has the signatory company carried out the actions that they said they would in their delivery plan?
 - ii) Industry sector level how has the <u>average abv and unit</u> <u>consumption by sector</u> (beer, cider, wine, spirits etc.) changed over the course of the pledge (to 2015)?
 - iii) Note I think we need to have further discussion about this I would be looking for something on the following lines: Market level have 1bn units been taken out of the market overall (as measured by HMRC clearance data) relative to an agreed counterfactual (Note I would suggest this is Office for Budget Responsibility Modelled consumption estimates) and has there been by a general reduction in the overall average abv as measured by Nielsen data?
- 2. After further discussion of the methodology and reporting process by CGA/AC Neilson, it was agreed at today's meeting that:
 - (i) The report will be in line with the original CGA/Neilsen proposal that was signed off by the monitoring group in April 2012.
 - (ii) The data sets and procedures outlined and agreed in the April monitoring and evaluation group meeting are the ones we are following specifically measuring volume, value and weighted average strengths by category and sub-categories identified.
 - (iii) The baseline will be the 2011 calendar year, with comparisions to subsequent calendar years, with the final success of the pledge based on the 2015 calendar year relative to the 2011 baseline. comparisons will be 2011 calendar year with 2012
 - (iv)(iii) The data and report from CGA/Neilsen will be with the monitoring group in March 2013
- 3. It was recognised that for certain spirits there are complications regarding legal definitions which specify specific minimum strengths for named spirit drinks. However, as this is a high profile gap in the achievement of the unit reduction pledge, innovative ideas for contributing to this pledge from the spirit drink industry would be welcomed.



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

This would prevent any worries about the report/data being left around in various in-boxes or even leaking out accidentally. We agreed at RDAN that the report/data would be shared with RDAN in May.
