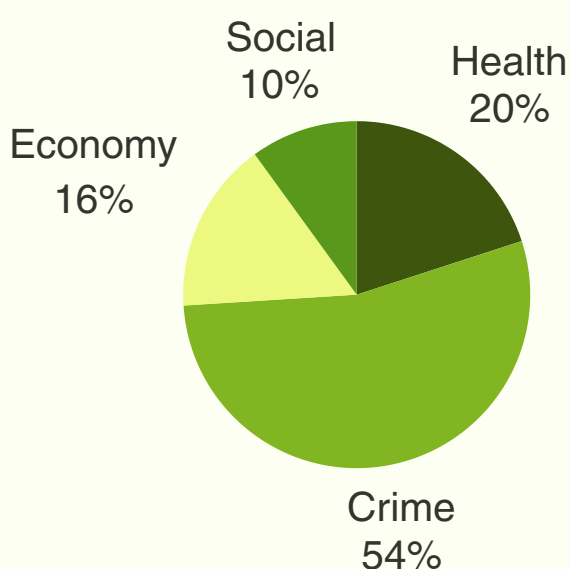

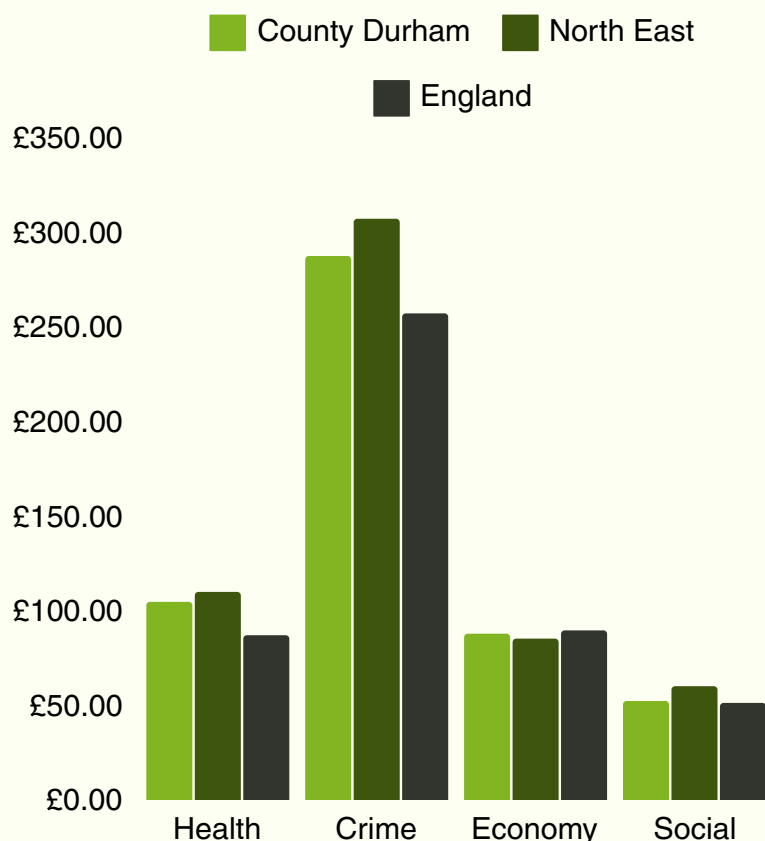

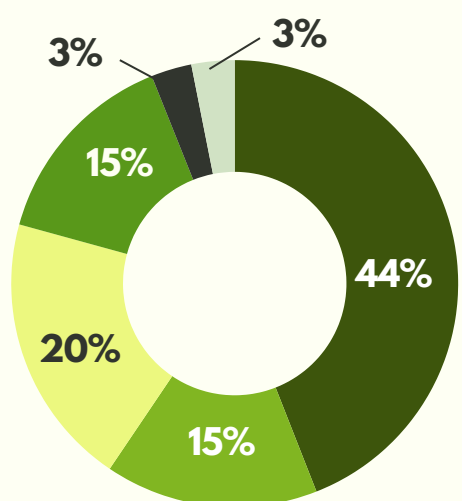

- Alcohol-related hospital admissions cost: **£24.0m**
- Outpatient visits cost **£8.4m**

- Alcohol-related healthcare appointments cost **£1.6m**
- Other alcohol-related healthcare cost **£1.7m**

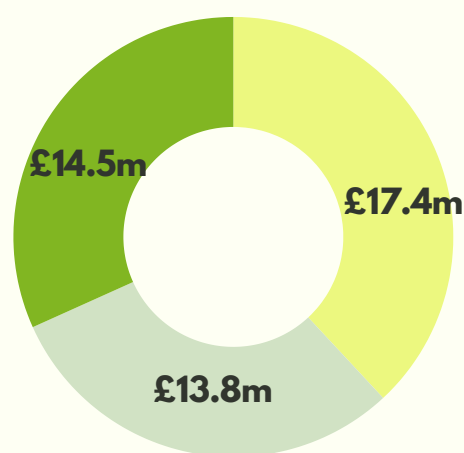
