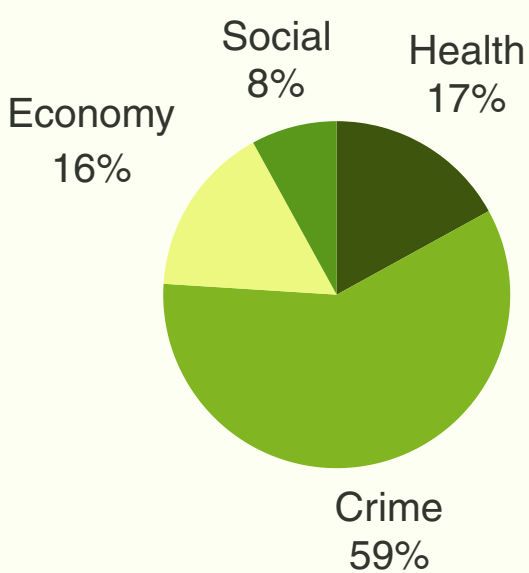


2021-2022 COST OF ALCOHOL HARM IN

COST BREAKDOWN

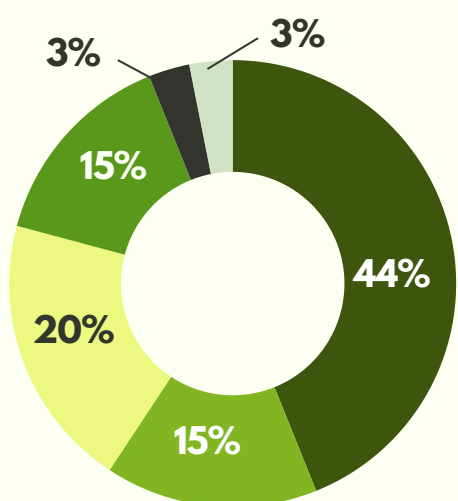

- Alcohol-related hospital admissions cost: **£13.7m**
- Outpatient visits cost **£4.8m**
- Alcohol-related A&E visits cost **£6.2m**
- Alcohol-related ambulance call-outs cost **£4.6m**
- Alcohol-related healthcare appointments cost **£928,511**
- Other alcohol-related healthcare cost **£973,441**

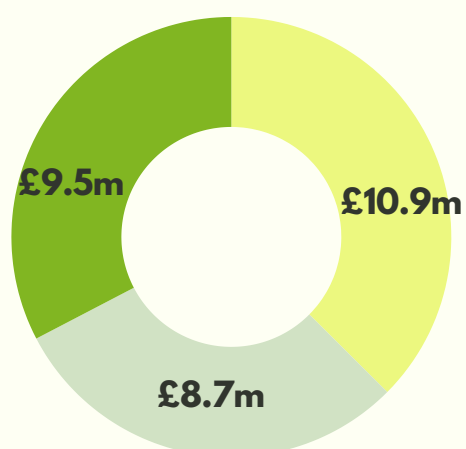
