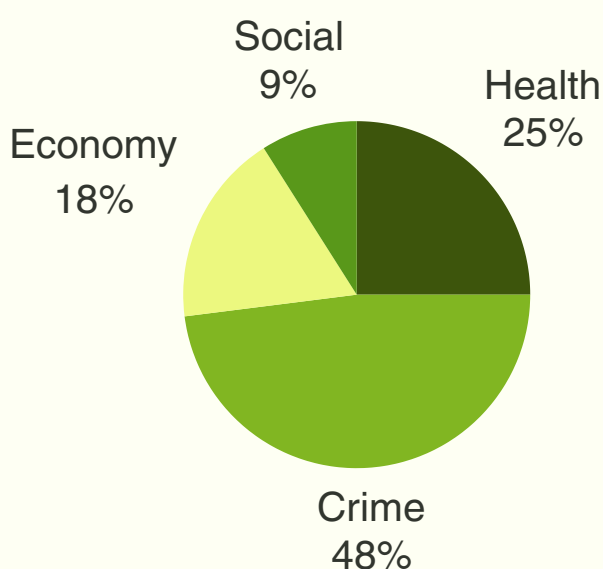

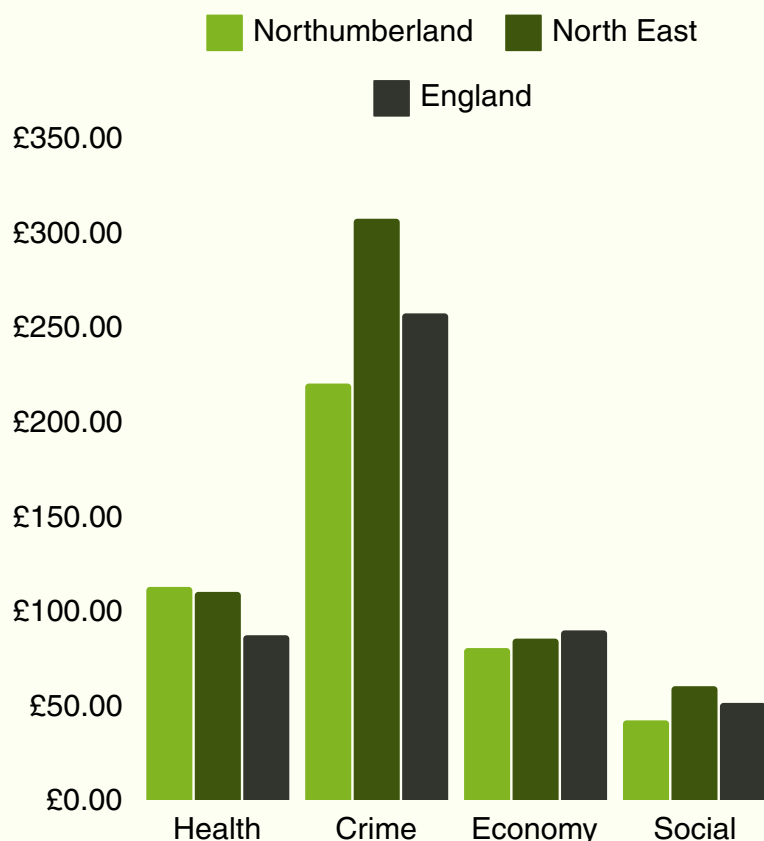

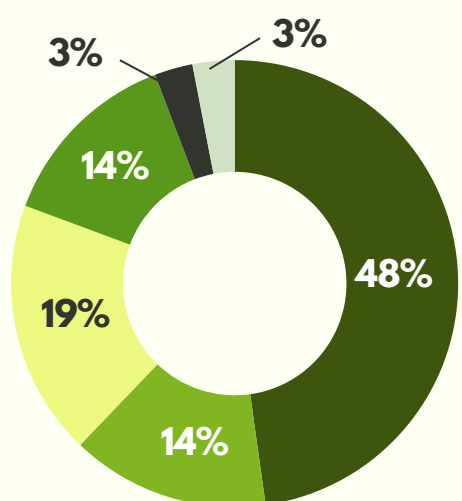

- Alcohol-related hospital admissions cost: **£17.3m**
- Outpatient visits cost **£5.2m**
- Alcohol-related A&E visits cost **£6.7m**
- Alcohol-related ambulance call-outs cost **£4.9m**
- Alcohol-related healthcare appointments cost **£1.0m**
- Other alcohol-related healthcare cost **£1.1m**

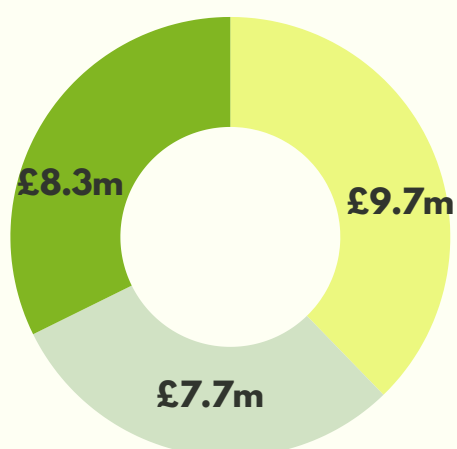
