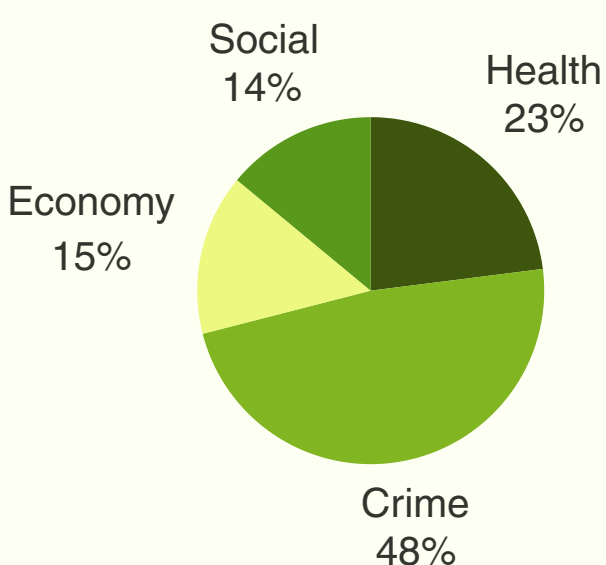

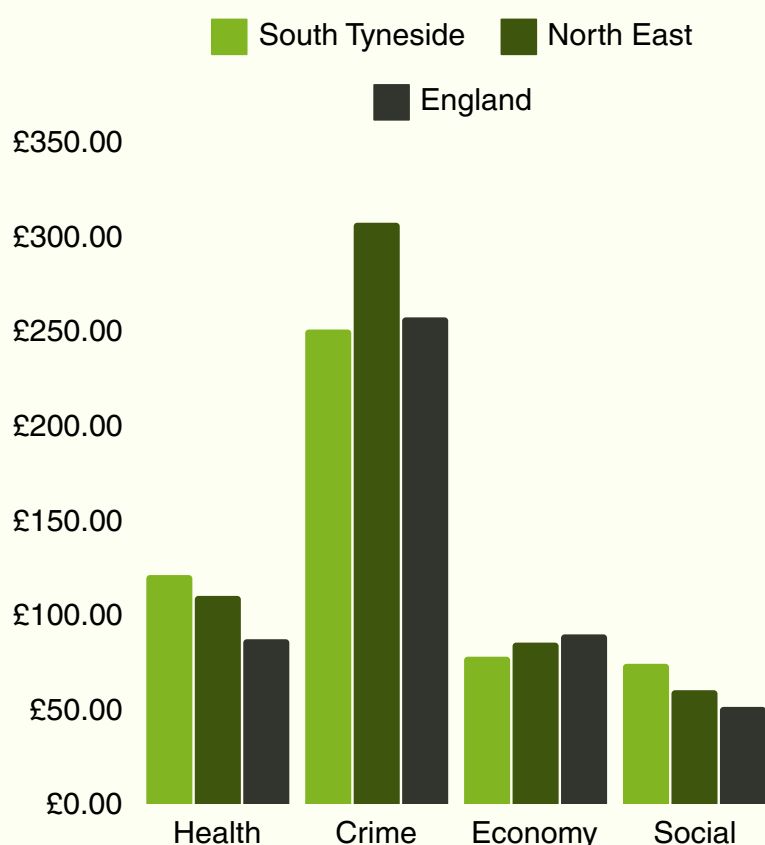

COST BREAKDOWN

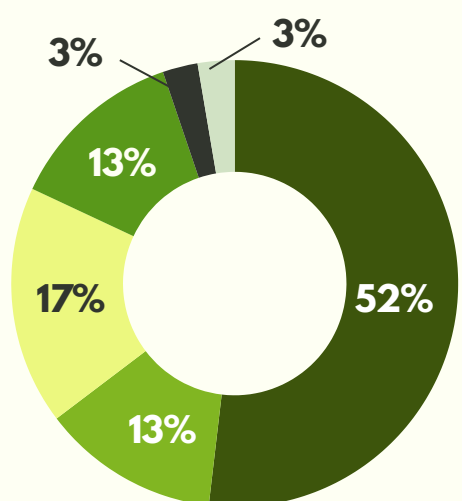


OVERALL COST: £77.3m

- Alcohol-related hospital admissions cost: **£9.3m**
- Outpatient visits cost **£2.3m**
- Alcohol-related A&E visits cost **£3.1m**
- Alcohol-related ambulance call-outs cost **£2.3**
- Alcohol-related healthcare appointments cost **£455,987**
- Other alcohol-related healthcare cost **£478,052**

CRIME & DISORDER: £37.1m

Including reported and unreported crimes:

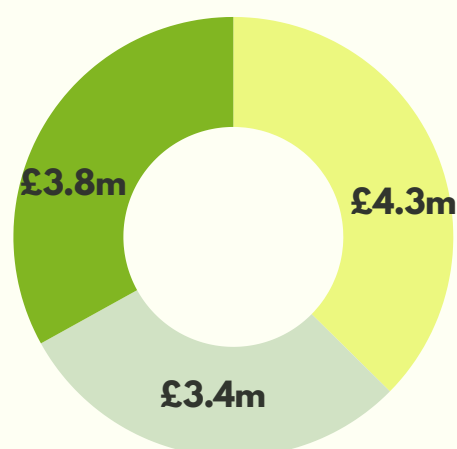
- 3,670 for criminal damage
