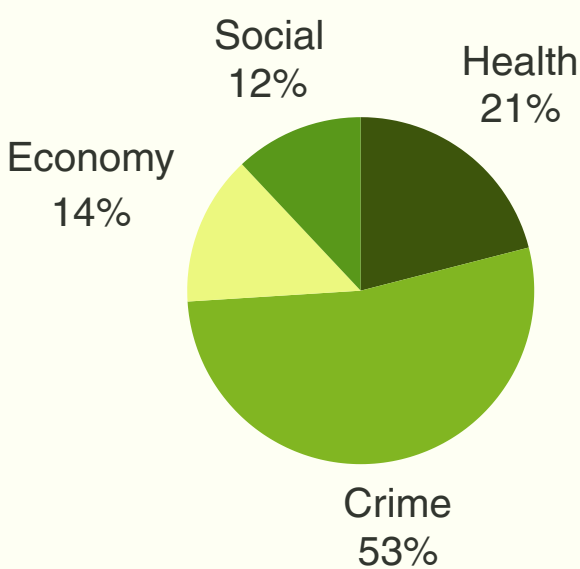

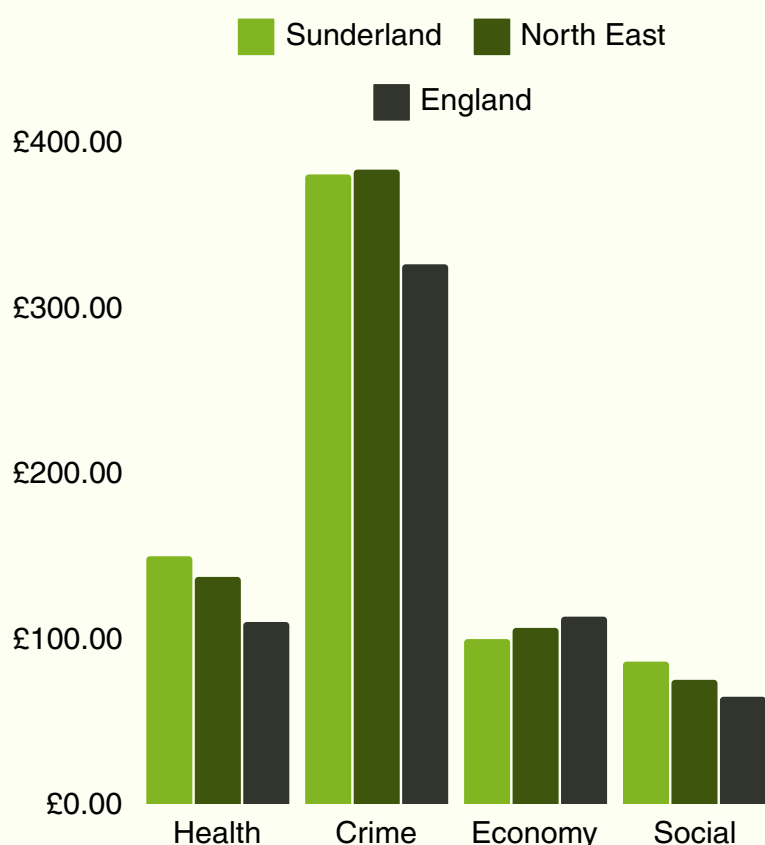

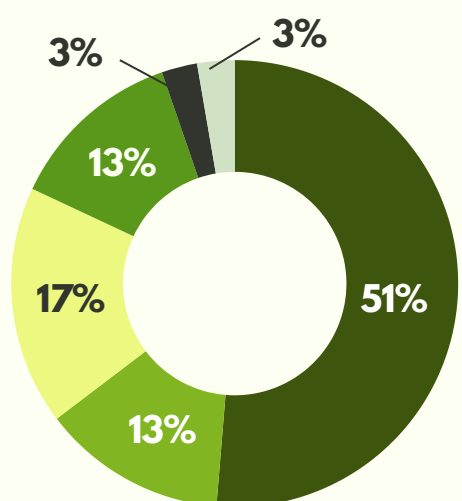


**OVERALL COST: £157.3m**

- Alcohol-related hospital admissions cost: **£16.9m**
- Outpatient visits cost **£4.4m**
- Alcohol-related A&E visits cost **£5.7m**
- Alcohol-related ambulance call-outs cost **£4.2m**
- Alcohol-related healthcare appointments cost **£849,314**
- Other alcohol-related healthcare cost **£890,413**

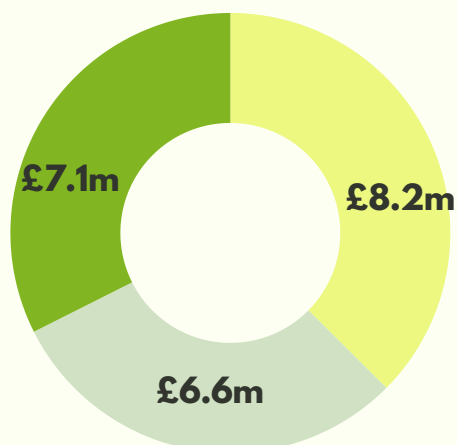
